What's Happening in Fourth Grade this Week?

Religion: The Second Commandment – God's name is holy; we call upon God's name with respect

Math: Compatible numbers/division continues; dividing 5 digit numbers for some students; comparison shopping

Spelling: Unit 19 – Words with /le/ endings + 5 challenge words (Study your words each night, please!)

Vocabulary: Unit 19 – Animal Content Words such as "ram/ewe"

Social Studies: Chapter 6 – The End of the Missions; Identify Facts and Opinions; Rancho Customs; Work on the Rancho

Science: Weather/Meteorology studies continue; precipitation; air masses; predicting the weather (we still need more weather pages)

Language Arts: Because of Winn-Dixie concluding chapters; we'll watch the movie on Thursday; predicting outcomes/character analysis

English: Adjectives conclude with comparisons using more/most and good/bad; we'll use a thesaurus for synonyms
