Curriculum

Aligned with the Diocese of San Diego and California State Standards, we provide a challenging, comprehensive, and relevant curriculum based on the needs of the individual child.

Class Size

Generally, no more than 24 students will be enrolled in a class without a teacher’s aide. If additional students are enrolled in a class, a teacher’s aide is used to assist in instruction and classroom management.

Our Teachers

The faculty and administration are state credentialed, professionally qualified and dedicated to the fulfillment of the Philosophy and Mission Statement of our school.

Uniforms

Discipline

Discipline is maintained in a classroom or school when pupils work cooperatively with the principal, teachers, and parents towards the attainment of the class and school objectives. Each teacher posts a Classroom Discipline Plan covering rules specific to each grade.

Tutoring

Homework Club is available Monday through Thursday. All teachers also make themselves available to help any individual student as needed.

After School Care

Any child in K-8 who is enrolled in St. Francis School is eligible for the After School Care Program, which operates both before and after school until 5:30 p.m.

Parent Involvement

The school relies heavily on the support of our parents through volunteer opportunities, room parents, and our Parent Teacher Group (PTG) activities. PTG is an integral part of the school’s operation by sponsoring fund raising activities and community events

Service Hours

Active involvement in the life of the school and parish is encouraged. Families and are encouraged to contribute their time and talents as stewards to our community.
